Why?

What?

- Payment and transaction histories

How?

All financial companies share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons why financial companies are able to share their customers' personal information, why First National Bank of Pasco chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do			
How does First National Bank of Pasco protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.		
How does First National Bank of Pasco collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information when you: Open an account or deposit money. Pay your bills or apply for a loan. Use your credit or debit card. We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.		
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only: Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness. Sharing for affiliates to market to you. Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you. State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. 		
What happens when I limit sharing for an account, I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.		
Definitions			
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include financial companies with a direct ownership connection to First National Bank of Pasco, such as FirstFin Credit.		
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our nonaffiliates may include financial and nonfinancial companies that share a common goal with First National Bank of Pasco.		
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include financial institutions such as insurance companies and financial product or service marketing companies.
